

## The Undergraduate Experience

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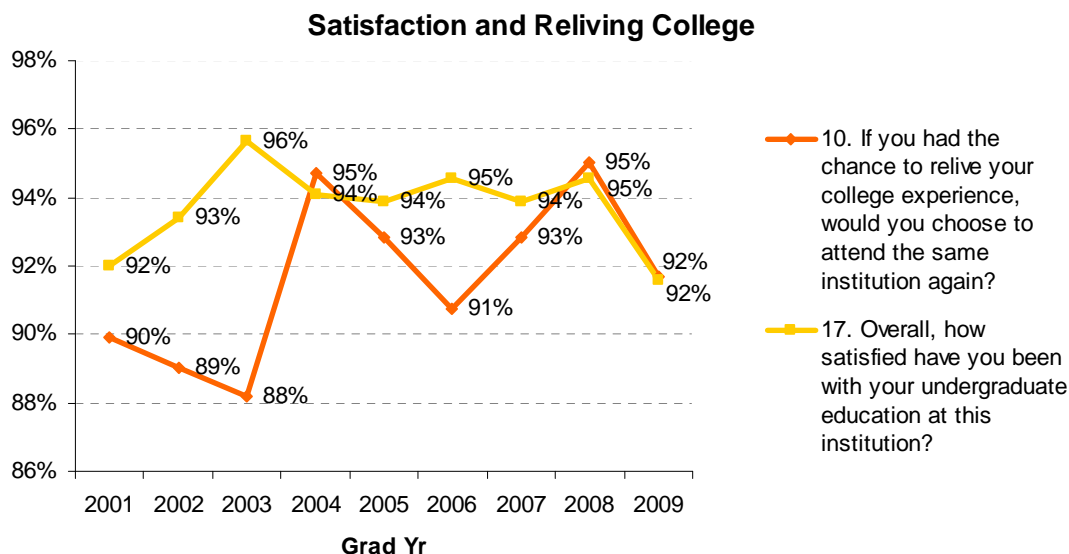
Prior to seniors graduating in May, they complete a survey evaluating their undergraduate experience while at Pitzer College. The Senior Survey has been outsourced to Higher Education Data Sharing Consortium (HEDS) since 2001. The survey has two parts. The first part asks about future plans (i.e., employment, graduate school) and has been reported in “Life After Pitzer” found on the website at: [www.pitzer.edu/offices/institutional\\_research/](http://www.pitzer.edu/offices/institutional_research/)

This report is the second part to the Senior Survey and encompasses questions about satisfaction and participation in various on- and off-campus activities. Also, results are presented here starting with the 2001 group of seniors. Details of results begin on page 9.

Prior to 2009, students completed the paper version of the survey. In 2009, the survey was administered online. To increase response rate further, students who did not complete the online version were asked to complete a paper version during Graduation Rehearsal Day.

### Summary

- The 2009 seniors were slightly less satisfied with their undergraduate education than the 2008 seniors. Ninety-two percent (187) of the 2009 seniors would choose Pitzer again to relive their college experience while 8% (17) would not choose Pitzer again (Page 11).



- More than 80% of the 2009 seniors indicated that Pitzer made “moderate” or “great” contributions to their skills and knowledge, self-knowledge, independent thinking, and issues of diversity. Around half of the senior students indicated that Pitzer contributed moderately or greatly to their knowledge of foreign language, science, experimentation, and quantitative tools (Pages 12-18).

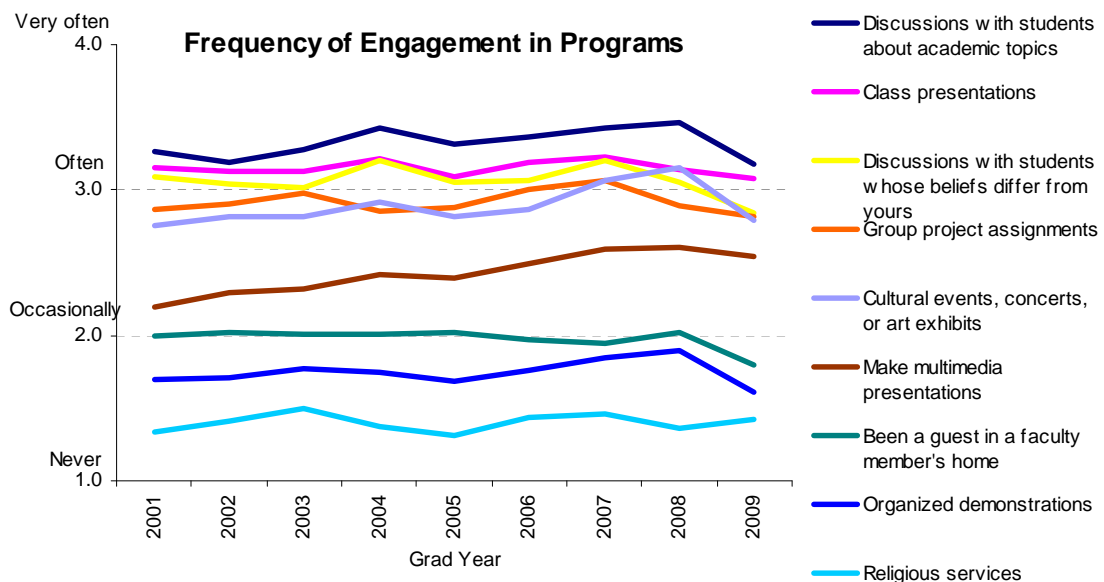

- Sixty percent of the 2009 senior students reported to have spent a semester or year studying abroad, 53% reported to have participated in independent study/research, and 49% reported to have participated in off-campus internship. Last year, 57% reported to have spent a semester or year studying abroad, participated in independent study/research, and participated in off-campus internship (page 18).

- During their four years at Pitzer, 60% of the students participated in volunteer service, 30% in social action/issues group, 28% in intramural/recreational athletics, 26% in performing arts, and 23% in intercollegiate athletics (Pages 19-20).

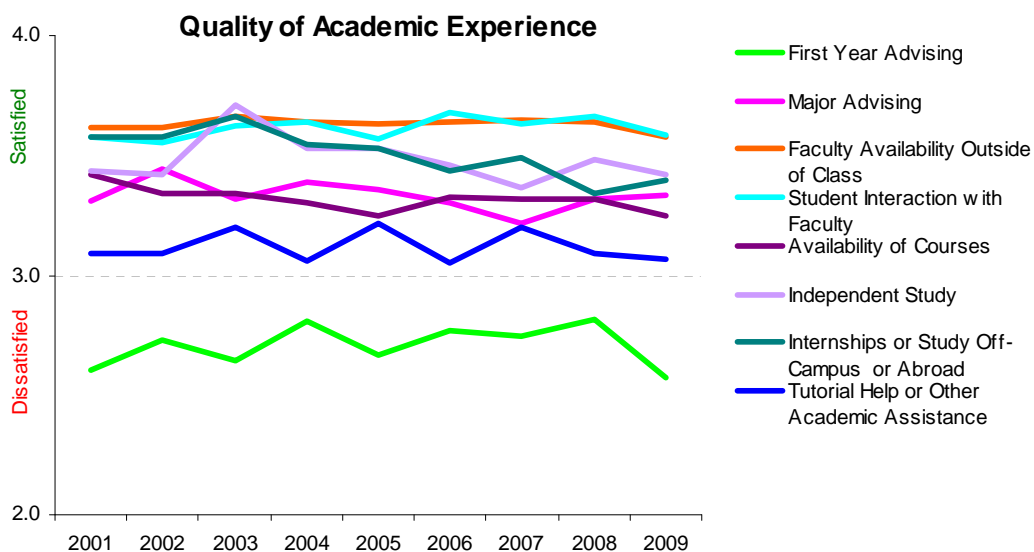
- The 2009 senior students indicated that they “often” or “very often” had topical discourse with other students, class presentations, discussions with students of different belief background, group project assignments, and attended cultural events/art exhibits. They also reported to have “occasionally” been a guest in a faculty member’s home (Pages 21-22).



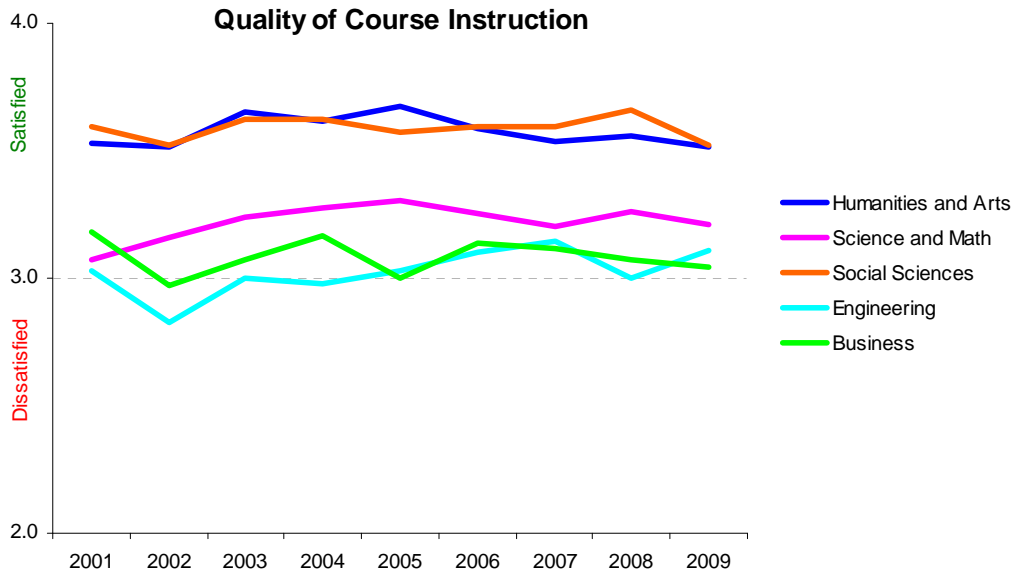
- Sixty to eighty percent of the 2009 seniors spent six or more hours per week attending classes and labs, studying and preparing for class, using computers for academics, and socializing with friends. A bit more than half work for pay (Pages 23-28).

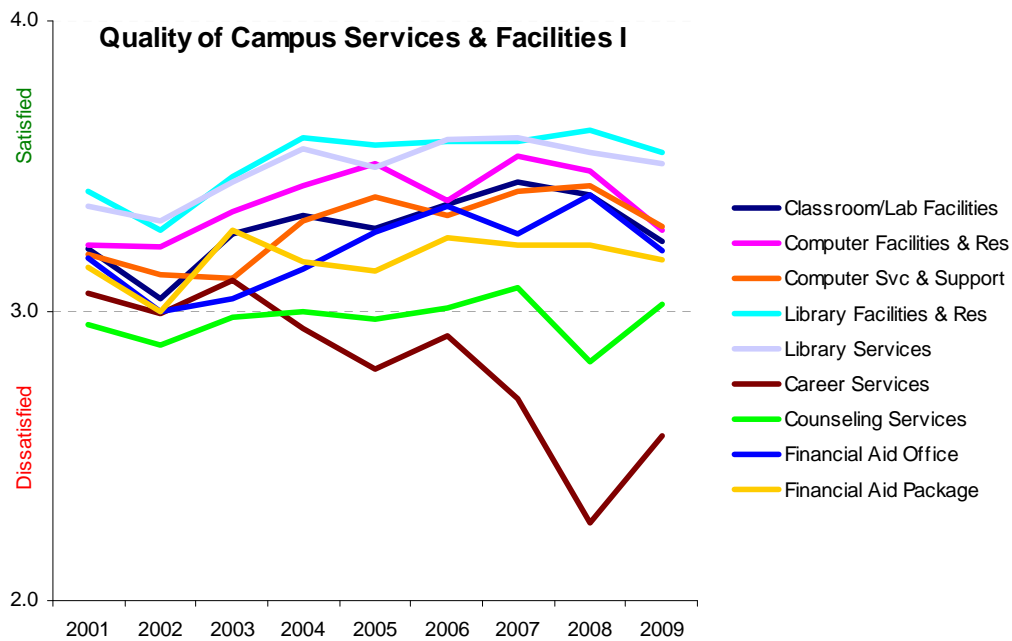
- For the most part, students were generally satisfied with many programs and services related to their academic experience. However, senior students in the last several years were dissatisfied with their first year advising (Pages 29-30).



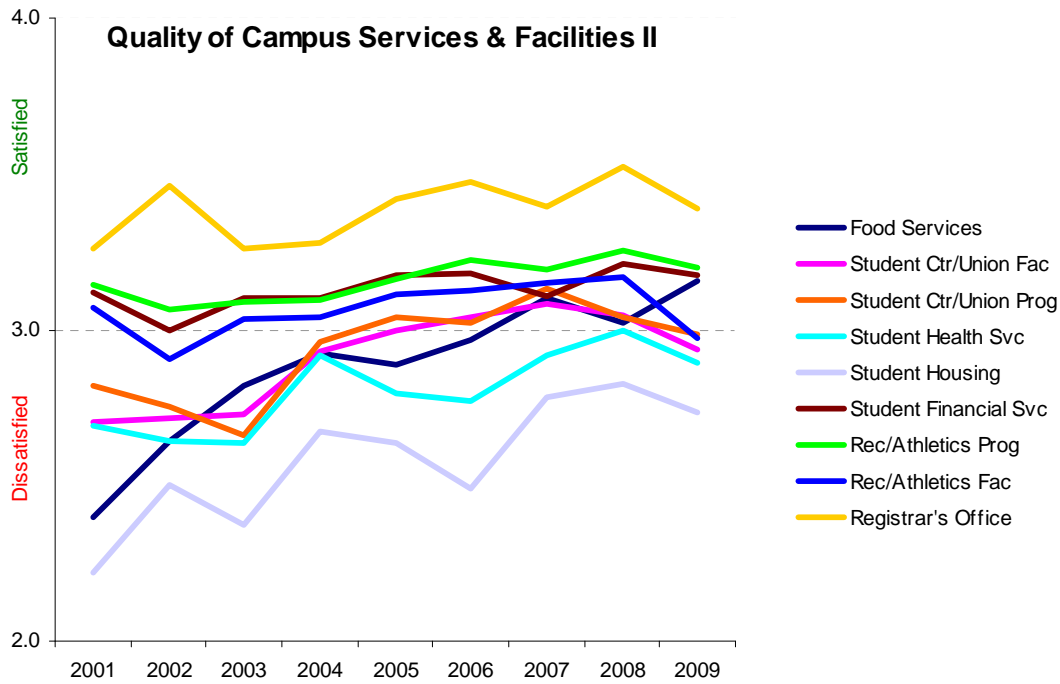
- For quality of course instructions, students' average ratings fell on the generally satisfied range (Pages 31-32).



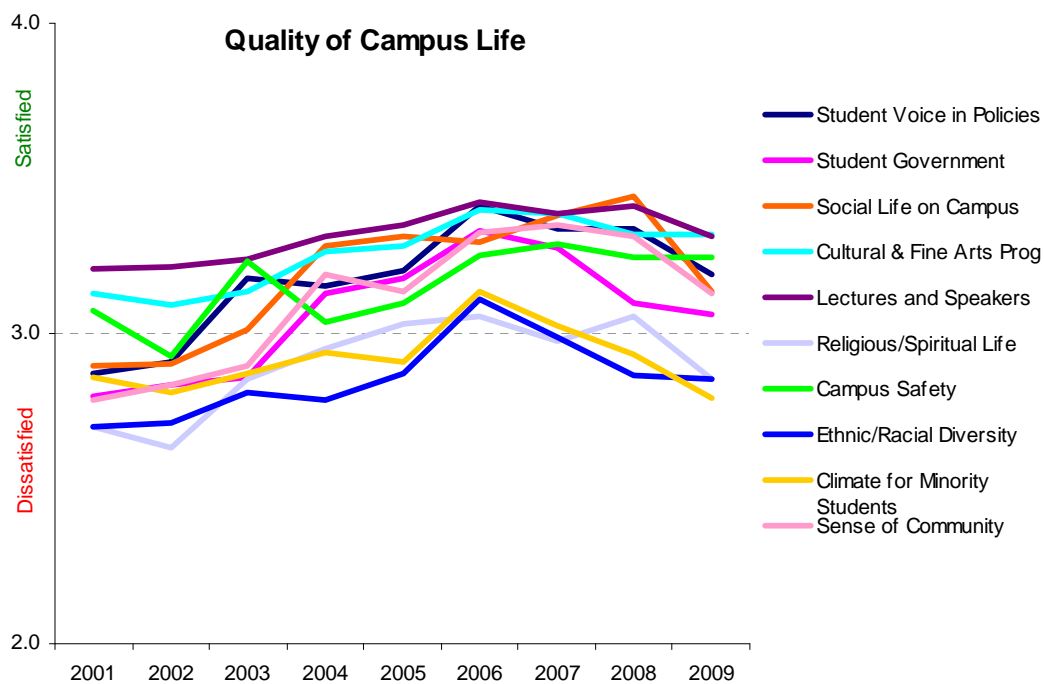
- Average ratings for quality of campus services and facilities were generally favorable. Career services continued to score on the dissatisfaction range although this was an improvement from last year's rating (Pages 32-34).



- Other campus services and facilities appear to have improved over time. The Registrar's Office appears to score the highest in terms of satisfaction. Students were dissatisfied with student housing although ratings have generally improved over time (Pages 34-36).



- Average ratings for quality of campus life appear to improve each year. Climate for minority students on campus and ethnic/racial diversity appear to score slightly on the dissatisfaction range (Pages 37-39).
