Guidelines:

- 1. The back panel of each bench will be painted white before and after each artwork and identified as a site for art by small, stenciled orange logo (4" square) on lower left corner
- 2. The bench located on the lower mounds should be reserved for ephemeral works (can be painted on a weekly basis) to coincide with Pitzer events and happenings.
- 3. All other benches will be reserved for semi permanent artworks
- 4. All artworks will be up for 3 months
- 5. All proposals for the benches must be submitted to Aesthetics Committee for consideration
- 6. Participants must be prepared to paint over existing artwork (with white paint) before starting their project.
