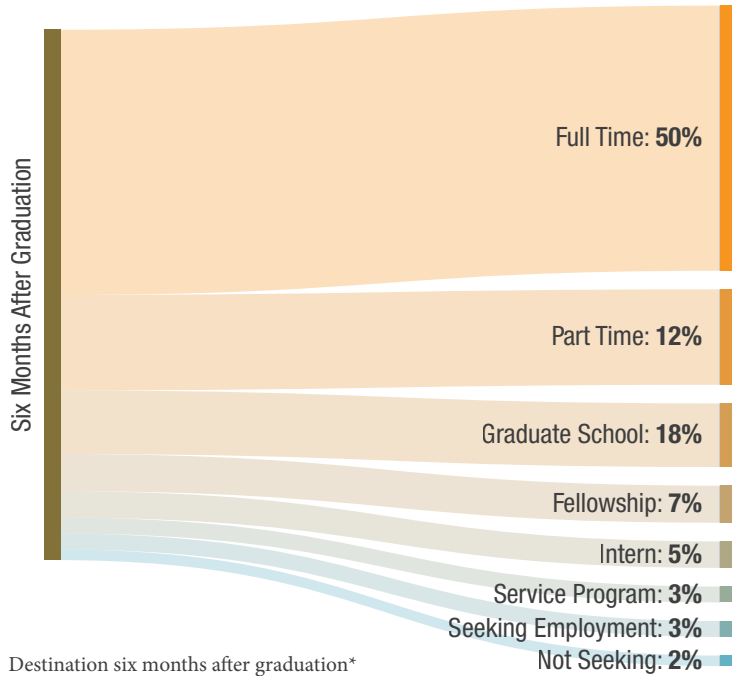
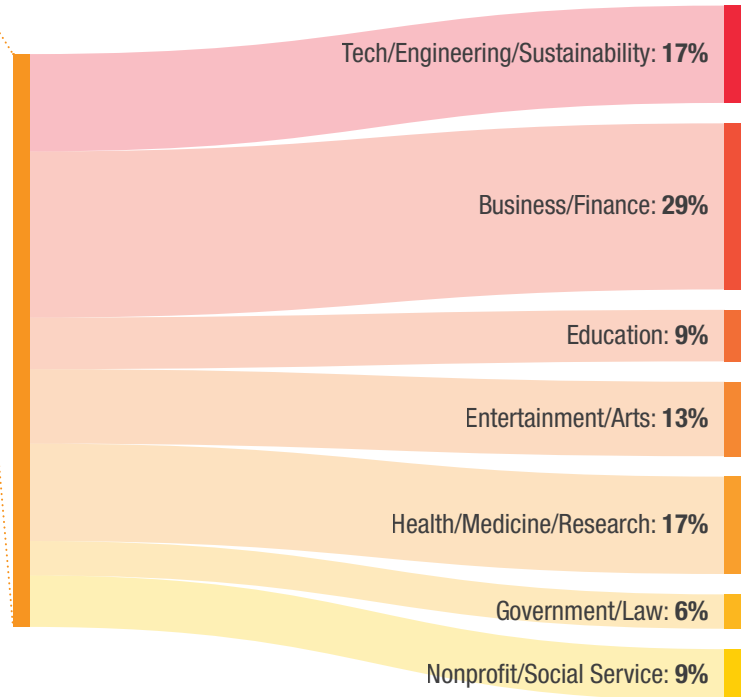

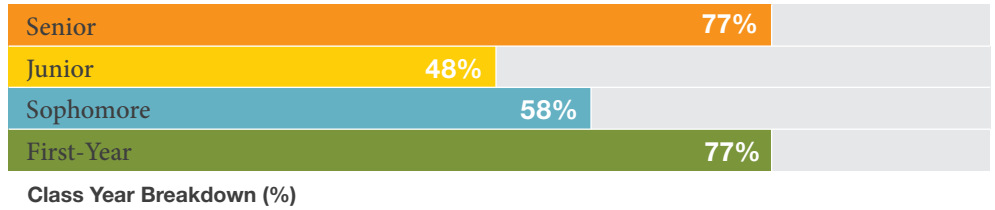

## Special Initiatives

### Industry Dinner Series

Launched in fall 2018, the Industry Dinner Series connected students weekly to alumni, parents, and employers from a variety of industries in an informal setting.

### Career Excursions

Career excursions in the Los Angeles area expose students to a variety of career options and work environments.

### Career Meet-ups

Launched in spring 2019, Pitzer Career Services is following a national trend of moving away from the traditional career fair and connecting students to employers in a more friendly and less formal environment.

### Pilot Internship Course
