

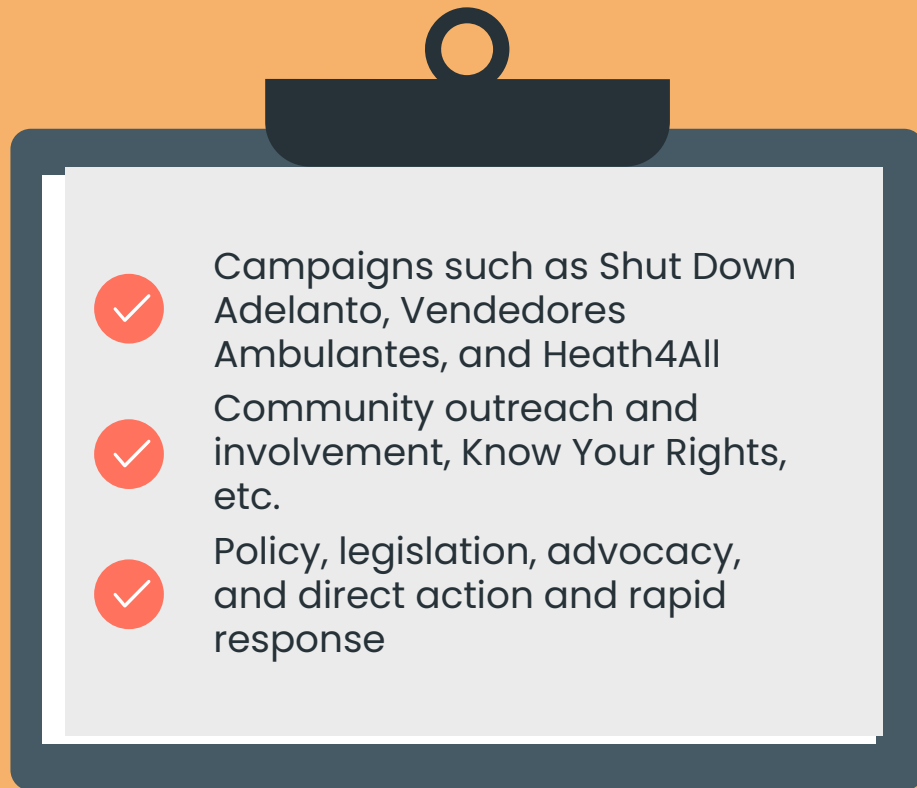

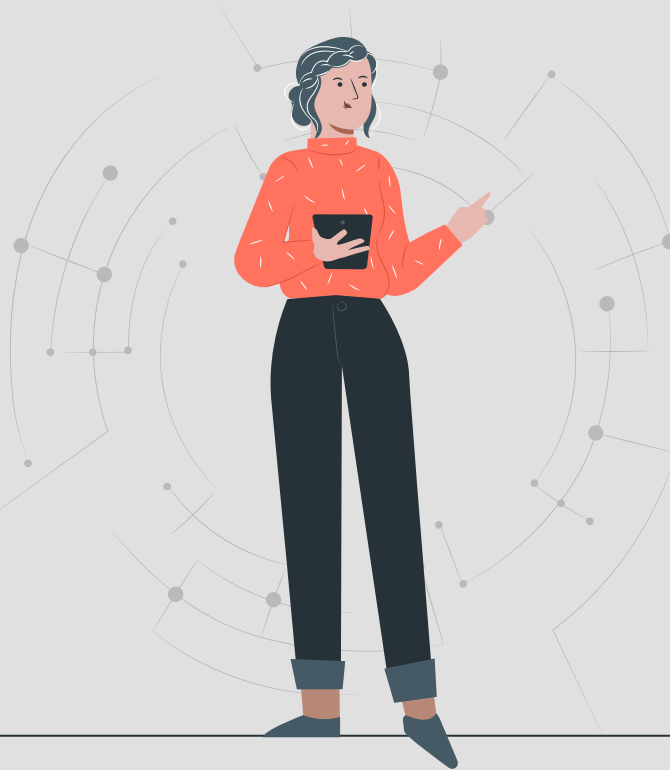

Research

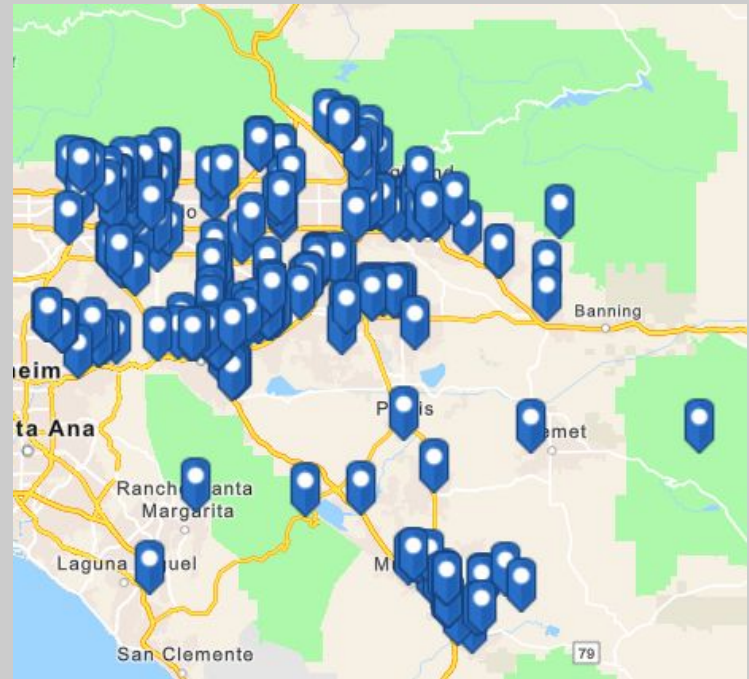
Originally planned on looking at the presence of ticketing during the pandemic- but shifted to reviewing hundreds of restaurants in different counties, cities, & municipalities and looking at their approach to outdoor seating/ dining and mapping them.



Takeaways...

Less than $\frac{1}{3}$ of restaurants in the Inland Valley Region (San Bernardino, Riverside, and parts of LA County) are currently offering outdoor dining or outdoor seating. For the purposes of the study, “dining” was defined as a sit-down order-in experience, while “seating” is more often reserved for casual eating or fast-food.

The map may help explain fluctuations in success for street vendors and places to avoid or visit more
