Starting with the 2019-2020 academic year, Pitzer's policy is to allow outside scholarships to reduce the student's summer earnings contribution\*, followed by their need-based loan, and then work-study. If your outside scholarship(s) exceed the amount of your summer earnings contribution, loan and work, a reduction may be made to your Pitzer Scholarship.

\*All students have an automatic summer earnings contribution that ranges from \$900–\$1,850, depending on various factors. This contribution is part of the overall family contribution and is used when determining your aid eligibility.
