Frequently Asked Questions

**“IF I HAVE ACCOMMODATIONS, CAN I BE IN THE SAME SUITE AS FRIENDS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN ACCOMMODATIONS?”**

No, accommodation are placed first and cannot pull in a group. If you’f prefer to stay with your roommate group, you can waive your housing accommodation and go through the lottery process.

**“DO I NEED TO RE-SUBMIT AN ACCOMMODATION APPLICATION IF I’VE GOTTEN ACCOMMODATIONS IN THE PAST?”**

Yes, you need to complete an accommodation application for this year. You can use the same documentation that has been used in the past. However, it is not guaranteed you will be automatically approved.

**“WHAT ARE MY CHANCES OF GETTING A SINGLE?”**

Pitzer has a limited number of singles available. Singles will first be offered to students with APPROVED accommodations. If any singles are available after accommodation placements, they will be entered into the general housing lottery. The general housing lottery is based on class with rising Seniors selecting first, followed by rising Juniors, and then rising Sophomores. Please note the availability is extremely limited and singles are not guaranteed. You should have a plan in mind for if you don’t receive a single
